Topic: Assessment of Learning, assessment for learning and assessment as learning

Message Objective(s): To highlight the different forms of assessment as they pertain to learning

There are broadly three forms of assessment that can be effectively utilised during teaching and learning.

1. Assessment of Learning

- -Conducted at the end of a learning period, section or objective
- -Designed to provide evidence of learning and used as a measure of achievement
- -Also referred to as **summative** assessment
- -Used to give evidence of achievement for promotional and progressional purpose to prospective employers or higher institutions

2. Assessment for Learning

- -Happens during the course of learning
- -Designed to give teachers insight into the learning process. What do learners know or can do? What are the preconceptions and misconceptions learners have?
- -Also referred to as **formative** assessment
- -The purpose is to give the teacher instructional strategy and direction.

3. Assessment as Learning

- -Involves learners own reflection and cognition of their own learning an thought processes
- -Helps learners to take responsibility of their own learning
- -Can also be referred to as part of metacognitive processes
