Topic: Comprehension (Reading and Viewing)

Message Objective(s): Learners should be able to:

- ✓ Read for meaning
- ✓ Deduce meaning of a text from the title, author, introduction and conclusion
- ✓ Find main idea

**Message:** Comprehension is the interpretation and understanding of spoken, written and visual texts. Leaners need to learn to read for meaning.

## **Guidelines for reading for meaning**

- 1. Scan through the text
  - Get an outline of what the text is about
  - Visualise what you are reading
- 2. Take note of the following:
  - Title: offers a clue to the content and purpose of passage
  - The author: helps to identify the time, style and subject
  - Introduction: creates the atmosphere and provides the setting
  - Conclusion: ties up the intension of the author
- 3. Question words: who, what, where, when, why, how (learn the requirementa of each question word)
- 4. Read comprehension questions before reading the passage.
- 5. Read the passage again and highlight main idea of each paragraph

The more familiar the learner is with the passage, the easier it should be to interpret and understand what they are reading.
