Paper 2 (150): Euclidean Geometry (40 marks), Analytical geometry (40), Trigonometry (50) and Statistics (20).

Learners and teachers should ensure that the study timetable is balanced and prepared according to the mark weightings. This will guard them against a trap of spending more time on topics with few marks.
