Topic: Writing a newspaper article

Message Objectives: To teach learners how to write a news article

To inspire budding journalists

Message:

A newspaper article:

- Factual and informational
- Written in short paragraphs
- Uses plain language
- Includes quotations from people who are witnesses or part of the story
- Written in the third person

Writing process:

- 1. Brainstorm a list of possible topics and pick one you are passionate about. Answer the following questions: Who? What? Where? When? Why? How?
- 2. Research your article topic. Background information makes the story more interesting.
- 3. Interview people relevant to your topic.
- 4. Write a rough draft of your story.
- 5. Revise and edit your story for any holes or errors in reporting. Add more information where needed or take out unnecessary information that detracts from the story. Include a picture where necessary.
- 6. Write a final copy of your story and submit it for publishing. Your final copy should be free of grammar and spelling errors and ready to be published.
