Adjectives are words that describe or modify nouns and pronouns in a sentence. They provide more detail, making it possible to create a picture of what the speaker or writer is talking about.

Adjectives usually express things that are observable through the five senses (touch, taste, sight, smell, and sound). Some examples of adjectives are *fresh, tall, beautiful, wooden, little, noisy...*
