Topic: Recovery through writing - Descriptive Essay

Message Objectives: Learners will learn about the elements of a descriptive essay and revise the writing process

Message:

A descriptive essay describes something – an object or person, an event or place, an experience or emotion, or an idea in detail.

Purpose

To provide readers with enough detailed descriptions for them to be able to picture or imagine the chosen topic.

Elements of a descriptive essay

- Topic
- Ideas
- Use of the five senses
- Use of figurative language e.g. metaphors, similes, adjectives and adverbs
- Use of precise language e.g. specific adjectives and nouns, and strong action verbs

Steps to essay writing

- Planning
- Drafting
- Editing
- Publishing
