Topic: Procedural text

Message Objectives: Learners will learn how to write a text that gives instruction or steps on how

to complete a specific task.

Message: A procedural text is a text which gives instructions on how to make or do

something.

Examples of procedural texts

Recipes

- Science experiments
- Instructions for playing games
- Manuals etc

Characteristics of a procedural text

- Uses action verbs e.g. Cut, Mix, Turn etc
- Uses simple present tense
- The information is presented in a step-by-step process.
- The goal is clearly stated.
- The materials or ingredients are listed.
- The steps are listed in order and are often numbered.
- Uses sequence words like first, then, next, finally are used.
