Often asked questions by practitioners in education are - Why the Recovery Planners and Trackers? What makes these resources stand out in the drive towards total curriculum recovery?

The recovery Planners and Trackers are systematically designed to enable teachers and learners to work smarter and harder in pacing up rebooting of the system.

Paging through the document, the following key features are noticed:

# 1. Conceptual chains across the grades

A schematic representation showing the progressiveness and cohesiveness at of concepts building one upon the other. Conceptual chains build solid understanding of topics in that grade/phase. They enable Teachers not only to track but also identify weak links where learners struggle. Teachers will also be able to identify which concepts have been moved from one grade to another.

#### 2. Amendments to the Annual teaching Plan

It is important to emphasize that the Recovery ATPs have the same content as CAPS. More importantly, the Recovery Planners and Trackers also have same content as the Recovery ATPs. This feature indicates the content for the term versus the time allocated and the changes made.
